Housing

1. Address the housing supply issue by creating a \$2 billion Regional Housing Infrastructure Fund, which will help provide essential infrastructure for new homes in regional areas.

Integrity

- 2. Establish an independent Whistleblower Protection Authority to give protection, oversight and enforcement for private and public sector whistleblowers.
- 3. Pass a Bill to End Pork Barrelling, which will stop the misuse of public money and make sure funding goes to projects that deserve it.
- **4. Remove the exceptional circumstances test required for NACC public hearings**, so that the NACC can hold public hearings when it is in the public interest to do so.

Cost of Living

- 5. Limit the worst excesses of corporate power in critical sectors by legislating an economy-wide divestiture power and protect supermarket suppliers and consumers by establishing a Supermarket Ombudsman.
- **6.** Lower household energy bills by **funding cheaper home batteries** and other energy efficient technology through an interest-free loan scheme.
- 7. Lower small business and primary producer energy bills by **creating a Small Business and Primary Producer Energy Incentive** for businesses with annual turnover of up to \$50 million and all primary producers to provide support for electrification, energy efficiency technologies, and soil health and carbon sequestration.

Climate Change and Energy

- 8. Triple micro-grid funding to \$150 million to help regional, edge-of-grid towns access reliable and secure power supply.
- 9. Extend the Renewable Heat Industrial Decarbonisation Program, by advocating for \$2 million over three years to support manufacturers to find the right technology to transition away from gas.

Health

- 10. Secure Commonwealth funding for a single-site, greenfield hospital at Albury Wodonga.
- 11. Establish a \$2 billion Building Rural Hospitals Fund to provide competitive, needs-based investment for new buildings, equipment and planning.
- 12. Secure \$33 million for rural universities to train more healthcare workers, plus \$52 million for extra Commonwealth Supported Places at rural universities in medicine, nursing and allied health.
- **13.** Secure prac payments for allied health students (including psychologists) and medical students to urgently address workforce shortages and cost-of-living pressures for students.

Regional Development

- 14. Improve access to phone and internet services by establishing an ongoing Regional Telecommunications Infrastructure Fund grant program that will deliver \$50 million a year for community groups and local governments.
- 15. Require a minimum of 24 hours backup power for critical phone towers in bushfire-prone areas.
- 16. Fix our road network by providing \$500 million per year to the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program.

Early Education and Childcare

17. Establish an ongoing non-competitive grant program for ECEC providers in thin markets to address inadequate supply of childcare in the regions and increase capital grants for new and upgraded childcare centres to \$1 billion.
